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## Sir Ernest Satow's General Correspondence (1906-1927)

The listing below refers to Sir Ernest Satow's general correspondence in retirement as it appears in the National Archives of the United Kingdom, ref. PRO 30/33 12 and PRO 30/33 13. To reproduce every letter with annotations would be a major labour and would probably not be worthwhile. On the other hand, a mere list can be instructive in its own way, and reference to the contents of letters may also assist scholars in evaluating their value in various projects. The approach is similar to the one adopted with the catalogue of the Takeda family letters at the Yokohama Archives of History, which includes a number written by Satow to his Japanese family.<sup>1</sup>

On other occasions he merely writes an outline of his answer on the letter with the date answered, or just the latter. Sometimes he also writes the date on which the letter was received.
